In November we presented our report to the *West End Neighborhood Association Board*. We asked for help to secure a container to store emergency supplies. The Board is moving forward with this idea, but it was not possible to include in the *Neighborfest* grant this year due to all the various requirements.

This January, three Westenders attended Santa Rosa City's event *Building Neighborhood Power* and advocated for the city to work with us to secure an acceptable site to store the emergency provisions. We suggested DeMeo Park. We are waiting to learn if our proposal will be considered.

Our team took a break over the winter; it is now March and we are up and ready to move forward. We will offer monthly meetings for Block Captains and neighbors interested in planning for our next emergency. All meetings will last one hour and feature time before and after to socialize. We recognize that for many neighbors time is limited.

Our first meeting will be on Wed March 25, 7-8pm. It will include preparations to deal with the potential threat of Coronavirus. We have created a short set of five questions that we can use to



engage our neighbors, we will share this with you at our first meeting.

Each meeting will focus on a topic that will help us prepare for the next emergency. So each meeting will start with a few new achievements then ask for what you need to be successful.
